HISTORY LESSON: Outside hitter Bethania De La Cruz used a record-setting effort to secure the 2022 Athletes Unlimited Volleyball season last April at Fair Park Coliseum in Dallas, Texas ... De La Cruz, who was a captain in all five weeks of the season, finished atop the leaderboard with a 1,315 -point lead over setter Natalia Valentin-Anderson.
© Outside hitters and setters accounted for seven of the top 10 finishes on the final leaderboard including the top six positions ... Valentin-Anderson's second-place effort garnered the highest finish by a setter in league history after Brie King was third on the final leaderboard in 2021.
© The 2022 season also featured the first match requiring a "Golden Set" in league history as Team Lichtman edged Team Valentin-Anderson, 78-76, in the penultimate match on April 16, 2022.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS: After holding its first two seasons at Fair Park Coliseum in Dallas, Athletes Unlimited Volleyball will play the 2023 campaign at Legacy Park in Mesa, Arizona ... The 320-acre facility opened on February 4, 2022, and features space for numerous sports.
© Legacy Park becomes the seventh different venue to host an Athletes Unlimited season
© There have been three venues selected to host multiple Athletes Unlimited seasons ... Parkway Bank Sports Complex in Rosemont, Illinois, has hosted all four Softball Championship Seasons in addition to the 2023 AUX Softball campaign ... Fair Park Coliseum, meanwhile, was the home venue for volleyball in 2021 and 2022 along with basketball in 2023 ... The last two lacrosse seasons have been held at USA Lacrosse Headquarters in Sparks, Maryland.

HELPING HANDS: Athletes Unlimited Volleyball made one adjustment to the scoring system for the 2023 season, giving middle blockers two points when they record a block assist ... Only middle blockers are eligible to receive points for a block assist.

UNITED NATIONS: The 2023 Athletes Unlimited Volleyball roster includes athletes from seven different countries or territories, including Thailand, Dominican Republic, Brazil, Germany, Spain, Puerto Rico and the United States ... In addition, the roster features athletes from 15 different states.

A DIFFERENT VIEW: After playing in the first two Athletes Unlimited Volleyball seasons, Cassidy Lichtman has moved into the role of Director of Sport, Volleyball for the 2023 campaign ... Lichtman finished her Athletes Unlimited playing career with 5,482 leaderboard points, the fourth-highest total in the league's history ... The former Stanford standout also stands third in league history with 19 career service aces and 258 career digs over 82 sets.

CAPTAIN'S LOG: Setter Nootsara Tomkom, who placed fifth on the final leaderboard last season, makes her debut as a captain in Week One, becoming the 17th player in league history to lead a team ... In addition, she will be the fourth different setter to serve as a captain, joining Natalia Valentin-Anderson Brie King and Kelly Hunter.
© Week One marks the first time in Athletes Unlimited Volleyball's three seasons where two setters are acting as captains in the same week.
U Valentin-Anderson authored a 5-4 record in three weeks as a captain last season ... King was 5-1 in her two weeks as a captain during the 2021 campaign, while Hunter dropped all three of her matches as a team captain during Week Four of the 2021 season.

PERFECT 10: Outside hitter Bethania De La Cruz will serve as a captain for the 10th consecutive week, extending her league records for most weeks and matches as a captain ... De La Cruz, who became the first athlete in any Athletes Unlimited sport to be a captain during an entire season in 2022, owns an 18-9 career record as a captain, including a 10-5 mark last season.

0 De La Cruz is one of three athletes in Athletes Unlimited history to post 10 or more victories as a captain in a single season ... Pitcher Cat Osterman was 10-2 in four weeks as a captain during the 2020 softball season ... In addition, attacker Sam Apuzzo fashioned 10 wins as a captain in the 2022 lacrosse campaign.
© De La Cruz's nine weeks and 27 career matches as a captain are both the highest career marks by a captain in any Athletes Unlimited sport ... Apuzzo stands second with eight weeks and 24 games as a captain in three lacrosse seasons.

TWO OF A KIND: Outside hitter Bethania De La Cruz could join lacrosse goalkeeper Taylor Moreno as the only athletes in any Athletes Unlimited sport to win multiple titles if she claims the 2023 crown ... De La Cruz would also join Moreno as the only athletes to secure back-to-back championships.
© After winning the 2022 title during her rookie campaign, Moreno edged attacker Sam Moreno by 12 points on the final leaderboard to repeat as the Athletes Unlimited Lacrosse champion.

DRESS REHEARSAL: Outside hitter Alli Linnehan collected a league-high 411 leaderboard points in the scrimmages held earlier this week ... The former Kentucky standout hit .259 with 10 kills and six solo blocks ... Meanwhile, outside hitter Leah Edmond paced the league with 26 kills and a 490 hitting percentage in two matches and was second on the leaderboard with 411 points.

STARS AND STRIPES: Four Athletes Unlimited Volleyball players competed at the FIVB Road to Paris Olympic Qualifier in late September ... Libero Morgan Hentz helped Team USA finish first in Pool C, while outside hitter Bethania De La Cruz led the Dominican Republic to a first-place effort in Pool A ... Setter Nootsara Tomkom (Thailand) and libero Nomaris Vélez Agosto (Puerto Rico) were also in the event.

## WHO WE ARE

Athletes Unlimited is a new model of professional sports where athletes are decision makers and individual players are champions of team sports. We literally change the game with faster play and fluid teams, delivering next-level competition and engagement in which every moment counts. Athletes Unlimited began in 2020 with Women's Softball and followed with Women's Volleyball (2021), Women's Lacrosse (2021), Women's Basketball (2022) and AUX Softball (2022). Athletes Unlimited is building the next generation of both athletes and fans.

Our athletes are in charge of their team and league decisions, and of their individual success. We reboot rosters and gameplay to create fast and exciting competition that speaks to contemporary sports fans, bringing them close to the action and the athletes in games where every moment counts. We incorporate the player-centric model that fans love about fantasy sports. We use digital media platforms and cutting-edge technology to connect fans deeply to athletes at the top of their game on and off the field, and to the game itself.

## HOW THE TEAMS ARE SELECTED

A draft will be held prior to each week's matches with the top four players in the individual leaderboard serving as the team captains. The captains will then fill their rosters by selecting 10 other players. Each draft will be held on the Tuesday before the week's matches.
Uniform colors will be assigned based on the team captain's rank on the leaderboard. The top-scoring captain's team will wear gold, while the second-highest point scorer's team dons orange jerseys. The third-place team will wear blue jerseys and the fourth-place team will wear purple jerseys.
Each team will consist of 11 players, including five PINs (outside hitters and opposite hitters), two setters, three middle blockers and one libero.

## RULES OF INTEREST

Match Duration: Each Athletes Unlimited volleyball match consists of three (3) sets regardless of whether a team wins two sets in the match. A set is won when a team scores 25 or more points while winning by a margin of two (2) points or more.

Golden Set: In the event the match score is tied after three (3) sets, a "Golden Set" will be played to determine the match winner. The "Golden Set" will be won by the team which scores five (5) points while winning by a two-point margin or when a team reaches 10 total points.

Substitutions: Teams are limited to a maximum of six (6) substitutions in each set. In the event any match requires a "Golden Set," teams will be permitted no more than two (2) substitutions for the additional set.
Timeouts: Each team is permitted a maximum of two (2) timeouts per set with each timeout lasting three minutes (3:00). In the event a "Golden Set" is necessary, each team will be given one (1) timeout for the additional set.
Media Timeouts: If neither team has called a timeout prior to one team scoring 16 points in a set, a media timeout of three minutes (3:00) will be called.
Time Between Sets: A timeout of five (5) minutes will take place between each set.
Captain's Challenges: A captain may initiate replay review of certain events subject to the provisions of the rule as set out below. Replay reviews triggered under this rule shall be referred to as a 'Captain's Challenge', or 'Challenge' for short.

Each team is entitled to two (2) challenges per set. In the event a "Golden Set" is played, each team will be granted one (1) challenge.

A team may use a Challenge to initiate replay review of the following events:
© Whether a ball is in or out
© Block touch
© Service line fault
© 3-meter line fault
© Center line fault
© Net touch
Any called fault, violation, or other decision by the match officials not listed above, or any non-call, is not a challengeable event.

## INDIVIDUAL LEADERBOARD

While traditional volleyball statistics are kept during each Athletes Unlimited match, players earn individual points by accumulating those statistics. Points accumulated by statistics, set and/or match wins and MVP selections are used to create an individual leaderboard, which determines captains for each week and the individual champion at the end of the season.

Points are awarded at the following increments during the match:

If a match requires overtime or a "Golden Set," the stats accumulated during the "Golden Set" do not earn any individual points for the athletes on the leaderboard. In addition, there are no additional team set win points for the "Golden Set."

In addition, athletes will be awarded 40 individual points if their team wins a single set. If the teams score the same number of points in a set, the points carry over to the next set.
Athletes on the winning team in each match will be awarded 60 individual points toward the individual leaderboard. The total score determines the overall match winner, which means a team may lose two sets, but win the overall match.

Example: The Gold Team loses the first two sets 25-23 and 25-23 to the Blue Team, but wins the last set, 25-17. The Gold Team wins the overall match points because they had the larger overall score, 71-67.

A total of three MVPs will be selected following each game by the athletes with the top player earning 60 points. The second MVP receives 40 points, while the third MVP claims 20 points.

## MEDALS

The top four players on the final leaderboard in addition to the Defensive Player of the Year will receive a medal designed and fabricated for Athletes Unlimited by Lisa Issenberg, founder of Kiitellä, inc. The front face of the medal represents the identity of Athletes Unlimited, while the back face of the medal leans into the specific sport, the year, location and words about Athletes Unlimited's vision, mission and values on and off the field - Excellence in Community and Leadership.

## ATHLETE COMPENSATION

Athletes are compensated in three ways during an Athletes Unlimited season, including base pay, win bonuses (set and match wins) and a leaderboard bonus. Athletes Unlimited also makes an additional donation equal to the athlete's win bonus to their selected cause partner.

## POSTSEASON AWARDS

At the conclusion of the 2023 Athletes Unlimited Volleyball season, the following awards will be presented during the closing ceremony:

The "Dream Team" includes one setter, one libero, one opposite hitter, two middle blockers and two outside hitters.

## THE BOOK OF UNLIMITED

The Book of Unlimited was designed, handmade and bound for Athletes Unlimited and serves as a record keeper of its leagues. The book, which was handmade by Tikhon Verygyn in his studio in Kyiv, Ukraine, weighs nearly 25 pounds, measures approximately $12 "$ by 18 " and contains nearly 500 pages. The champion, along with all who competed, are inscribed into the book. In addition, The Book of Unlimited also contains a history of achievements in Athletes Unlimited, including stories, highlights and events.
The book is opened during the Opening Ceremony for each season and is closed after the champion is named and her name is inscribed into the book. The tradition began during Athletes Unlimited Softball's inaugural season in 2020.
