KEEPING IT 100

Attacker **Charlotte North** scored her second hat trick in as many games as she surpassed the 100-career point plateau in her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career. She is the third player in the league's four-year history to record at least 100 points and did so in only 26 games. The Boston College standout and two-time Tewaaraton Award winner is third in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career points standings.

THREE OF A KIND

In addition to reaching the 100-point mark in her career, attacker **Charlotte North** scored her 15th hat trick in her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career in Team Apuzzo's 9-7 loss to Team Bosco on Saturday afternoon. The count is the second most in AU pro lacrosse history and ranks behind only attacker Sam Apuzzo who has scored at least three goals in a game 18 times.

SHUTTING THE DOOR

Goalkeeper **Kady Glynn** matched her career high in saves in a game in Thursday night's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season opener and returned to action on Saturday with a new personal-best 15 stops. The day marked the 14th time she has registered double-digit saves and stands as the third player in Athletes Unlimited history to make at least 15 saves in a game joining **Taylor Moreno** and **Britt Read**.

FRESH FACES

The 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse roster features 21 players in their first season with the league. Out of those 21, seven are inside the top 10 on the leaderboard after a pair of gamedays.

- Defender **Emily Nalls** surged six spots up the standings on Saturday to third with 314 points on the year, while midfielder **Ellie Masera** issued her second straight hat trick to move into fourth place with 306 points.
- Rookie defender **Kendall Halpern** is tied with Masera with 306 points, while rookie attacker **Isabella Peterson** stands in sixth with 299 points.
- Defender **Sydney Scales** and midfielder **Cassidy Weeks** each rose four spots into seventh and eighth place on the leaderboard, while attacker **Sydni Black** rounds out the newcomers in the top portion of the standings in 10th place.

AUSL TO DEBUT IN 2025

- ⌚ Athletes Unlimited announced the creation of the Athletes Unlimited Softball League (AUSL) in a press conference on June 4, 2024, in Oklahoma City.
- ⌚ The traditional softball league will launch in 2025, complementing the existing AU Pro Softball Championship Season and creating a new opportunity for the world's best softball players.
- ⌚ A minimum of four teams will compete during the inaugural season in 2025 with each squad playing a 30-game schedule. Each team will carry a 15-player roster.
- ⌚ The AUSL will become a city-based league beginning in 2026, while the inaugural 2025 season will be a touring property.
- ⌚ ESPN has signed on as a founding broadcast partner of the AUSL and will carry at least 18 games exclusively on its linear platforms (ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU) in 2025.

COMING FOR THAT NUMBER ONE SPOT

Midfielder **Katie O'Donnell** scored four times in Team Glynn's 12-9 loss to Team Moreno in Saturday's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action. For her efforts, O'Donnell was selected as the MVP 1 for the first time in her four-year Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career. It also marked her second-ever Game MVP honor. The Penn State product led the contest in scoring and also registered two draw controls and a ground ball.

GET OUT THE BROOMS

With Team Moreno's 12-9 win against Team Glynn to close out Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action at USA Lacrosse Headquarters on Saturday, the gold squad earned a clean sweep of the quarter points and game points. It was the 20th occurrence of a team sweeping all 125 games points in 82 all-time league games and the fourth time goalkeeper **Taylor Moreno** captained a team that completed the sweep. This was the first game points sweep of the 2024 season after nine teams earned all 125 game points in the 2023 campaign.

⌚ Attacker Sam Apuzzo has captained seven teams that have completed game sweeps, including all four occurrences during the 2022 season.

DRAWING THING UP

Midfielder **Livy Rosenzweig** set a new season high with 10 draw controls for Team Glynn in a 12-9 loss in Saturday's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse nightcap. The total is the second time in her career that she has recorded double-digit draw controls and is the most since she captured 13 draws, which is a single-game Athletes Unlimited record, on August 12, 2023 against Team Apuzzo. Out of the six instances that a player has finished a game with at least 10 draw controls, Rosenzweig has accounted for two of them.

SHUT IT DOWN

Goalkeeper and two-time defending Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse champion **Taylor Moreno** tallied 13 saves in her squad's 12-9 win against Team Bosco on Saturday afternoon. The total is her 20th time stopping at least 10 shots in her 29 career contests. The North Carolina product leads the league in most 10-save games in the four-year history.

IN CONTROL

With her 13 save performance and guiding her team to a game points sweep, goalkeeper **Taylor Moreno** earned MVP 2 plaudits for the fifth time in her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career. The five MVP 2 selections ranks tied for second-most in league history and her total Game MVP honors moves to 12, which is good for fifth-most all-time.

FROM LONG DISTANCE

Midfielder **Hannah Dorney** registered her first career two-point goal in Team Bosco's 9-7 triumph over Team Apuzzo on Saturday afternoon. She became the 21st player in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history to register a two-point goal, which came with just over two minutes left in the first quarter. The goal gave Team Bosco a 3-2 advantage at the time and earned the team the quarter win points as the scoreline stood for the rest of the period.

95 TO INFINITY

Attacker **Sam Apuzzo** scored a pair of goals in her team's 9-7 loss to Team Bosco in Saturday's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse opener. The two goals brought her career total to 95, which stands as the most in league history. She is just five goals shy of becoming the first player in AU pro lacrosse's four seasons to reach the 100-goal plateau. Apuzzo already stands as the all-time points leader with 138.

KEEP IT ROLLING

With her two goals on Saturday, attacker **Sam Apuzzo** has continued her record streak with a point in 41-consecutive Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse contests. The total equals her career best that she achieved three times previously. The three CTs led the game and Carr earned 137 leaderboard points to help her leap 29 spots to 24th in the standings.

BETTER LATE THAN NEVER

Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse rookie midfielder **Ellie Masera** scored three times in her professional debut to help lead Team Moreno to a 10-7 victory on Thursday night. The Stony Brook product gave Team Moreno an early lead as she scored the first goal of the game less than two minutes into play, but tallied her other goals late in the game clock. She scored with only seven seconds left in the opening period and completed her hat trick in similar fashion as she found the back of the cage with only two seconds remaining on the first-half clock.

SAVING THE DAY

Goalkeeper **Taylor Moreno's** 13 saves against Team Glynn in a 12-9 victory sends her career total to 298. She ranks second in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history in the category and is just two goalkeeper saves away from becoming the second goalkeeper in league history to reach the 300 save plateau, joining **Britt Read**.

Rookie attacker **Izzy Scane** erupted for four goals and an assist in a 9-7 win for Team Bosco against Team Apuzzo on Saturday. IN CASE WE GO TO OVERTIME ...

- There have been six overtime games in the three-year history of Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse ... In addition, there have been two games that required a shootout.
- Attacker **Sam Apuzzo** holds a 2-0 record in overtime contests ... Her squad defeated Team Moreno in the first-ever shootout by an 11-10 count on July 30, 2022, before edging Team Bosco, 7-6, on August 5, 2023.
- If a game requires overtime, players do not accumulate any individual stat points ... Only game win points and any quarter win points that rolled over from the end of regulation are awarded.
- Overtime in AU Pro Lacrosse consists of a three-minute "sudden victory" period ... If the score remains tied following the extra period, the game moves into a shootout to determine the winner.
- The shootout will consist of three rounds with a player attempting to score from outside the eight-meter key ... If the score is tied after the third round, teams will continue playing one round at a time until there is a winner.

BICENTENNIAL

Midfielder **Ally Kennedy** authored one of the most complete stat lines in Saturday's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action. Kennedy scored a pair of goals with one assist, three ground balls, three draw controls and a pair of caused turnovers. With her effort, the former Stony Brook standout earned MVP 3 laurels to walk away with 204 leaderboard points. The total is a new career-high for the midfielder and stands as the 19th player in league history to earn at least 200 leaderboard points in a single game.

THAT'S SO Mc-COOL

Midfielder **Marie McCool** scored a goal with an assist and five draw controls in Team Bosco's 9-7 victory against Team Apuzzo in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse's third game of the 2024 season. We reboot timetables, rosters, and gameplay to create fast and exciting competition that speaks to contemporary sports fans, bringing them close to the action and the athletes in games where every moment counts. We incorporate the player-centric model that fans love about fantasy sports. We use digital media platforms and cutting-edge technology to connect fans deeply to athletes at the top of their game on and off the field, and to the game itself.

HOW THE TEAMS ARE SELECTED

A draft will be held prior to each week's games with the top four players in the individual leaderboard serving as the team captains. The captains will then fill their rosters by selecting 13 other players. Each week's draft will be held on the Monday before the respective week's games.

Uniform colors will be assigned based on the team captain's rank on the leaderboard. The top-scoring captain's team will wear gold, while the second-highest point scorer's team dons orange jerseys. The third-place team will wear blue jerseys and the fourth-place team will wear purple jerseys.

All teams will consist of 14 players, including four attackers, four midfielders, four defenders and two goalkeepers.

RULES OF INTEREST

Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse playing rules are based on the NCAA rule book with several exceptions, including:

Field Size: The field is 100 yards long by 60 yards wide with 80 yards between the goals. In addition, the restraining line is the center line, but restraining lines will be in use for the draw. Instead of an eight-meter fan, Athletes Unlimited Lacrosse will use an eight-meter "key."

Timing: Four 10-minute (10:00) stopped time quarters will be played during a regulation game with a 60-second shot clock in play. There will be a three-minute (3:00) break between the first and second quarters and third and fourth quarters. Halftime will be 15 minutes in length.

Shot Clock Reset: The 60-second shot clock will reset if a shot attempt is a goal, saved by the goalkeeper or hits the crossbar or goal post.

Timeouts: Each team is permitted to take one timeout per quarter, but timeouts do not carry over if unused. If a team does not take a timeout before the five-minute mark of the quarter, a media timeout will be called at the next dead ball situation. The first timeout of any quarter (media or team-called) will be three minutes (3:00) in length and any subsequent timeouts in the period will be one minute (1:00) in length.

Overtime and Shootouts: In the event a game is tied at the end of regulation, a three-minute overtime period will be played following a one-minute break. If the game is still tied following overtime, a shootout will take place to determine the winner following a one-minute break. Three shooters from each team will alternate taking attempts from outside the eight-meter key with the team scoring more goals winning the shootout. If the shootout remains tied after three rounds, the shootout will move into a sudden-victory format where any player on the roster may take an attempt, including those who have previously participated in the shootout.

Foul Changes: Shooting space fouls are not called in Athletes Unlimited; however, walling will be enforced. Defenders cannot intentionally enter the shooting lane of an attacking player with the intent of blocking a shot. In addition, teams cannot intentionally position any number of defenders in front of the goal. Defenders are prohibited from entering the restricted area directly in front of the goal unless they maintain a one-stick length from the attacking player (Walling can still be called on a defender outside of the restricted area if they attempt to impede the attacking player's shot). No three-second defensive calls will be made and no touch fouls will be called, but players cannot be significantly displaced.

Dangerous Shots: Dangerous shot fouls can be called by the game officials. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team on or above the knee, a red card will be administered to the offending player. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team below the knee, a yellow card will be administered to the offending player.

Over and Back: Teams may not go back into the defensive half of the field once they establish possession in the offensive half. If a team violates this rule, possession is turned over to the defensive team.

Challenges: Teams will be permitted two (2) challenges per game, which are communicated to the officials via the captain or facilitator. The following situations may be challenged:

- Goals
- 2-Point Goals
- Whether the ball was out of the crosse when time expires in a period
- Dangerous Shots
- False Starts

Teams DO NOT retain their challenges if they are successful. The Challenge Official will make the final decision on all challenges.

Scoring: Teams may score a two-point goal if the shot is released outside the eight-meter key. In addition, goalkeepers can score with a goalkeeper crosse during game play (regulation and overtime).

INDIVIDUAL LEADERBOARD

While traditional lacrosse statistics are kept during each game, players earn individual points by accumulating those statistics. Those points are used to create an individual leaderboard, which determines each week's captains and the individual champion at the end of the season.

Athletes on the winning team in each game will be awarded 45 individual points toward the leaderboard.

THE BOOK OF UNLIMITED

The Book of Unlimited was designed, handmade and bound for Athletes Unlimited. The book weighs nearly 25 pounds, measures approximately 12" by 18" and contains nearly 500 pages. The champion, along with all who competed, are inscribed into the book. In addition, The Book of Unlimited also contains a history of achievements in Athletes Unlimited, including stories, highlights and events.

The book is opened during the Opening Ceremony for each season and is closed after the champion is named and her name is inscribed into the book. The tradition began during Athletes Unlimited Softball's inaugural season in 2020.

Defenders are prohibited from entering the restricted area directly in front of the goal unless they maintain a one-stick length from the attacking player (Walling can still be called on a defender outside of the restricted area if they attempt to impede the attacking player's shot). No three-second defensive calls will be made and no touch fouls will be called, but players cannot be significantly displaced.

Dangerous Shots: Dangerous shot fouls can be called by the game officials. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team on or above the knee, a red card will be administered to the offending player. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team below the knee, a yellow card will be administered to the offending player.

Over and Back: Teams may not go back into the defensive half of the field once they establish possession in the offensive half. If a team violates this rule, possession is turned over to the defensive team.

Challenges: Teams will be permitted two (2) challenges per game, which are communicated to the officials via the captain or facilitator. The following situations may be challenged:

- Goals
- 2-Point Goals
- Whether the ball was out of the crosse when time expires in a period
- Dangerous Shots
- False Starts

Teams DO NOT retain their challenges if they are successful. The Challenge Official will make the final decision on all challenges.

Scoring: Teams may score a two-point goal if the shot is released outside the eight-meter key. In addition, goalkeepers can score with a goalkeeper crosse during game play (regulation and overtime).

INDIVIDUAL LEADERBOARD

While traditional lacrosse statistics are kept during each game, players earn individual points by accumulating those statistics. Those points are used to create an individual leaderboard, which determines each week's captains and the individual champion at the end of the season.

Points are awarded at the following increments during the game:

If a game requires overtime and/or a shootout, the stats accumulated during the extra period or shootout do not earn any individual points for the athletes on the leaderboard.

In addition, athletes will be awarded 20 individual points if their team wins a single quarter. If the teams score the same number of points (goals + two-point goals) in a quarter, the points carry over to the next quarter.

Athletes on the winning team in each game will be awarded 45 individual points toward the leaderboard.

Three MVPs will be selected following each game by the athletes with the top player earning 45 points. The second MVP will receive 30 points, while the third MVP claims 15 points.

POSTSEASON AWARDS

At the conclusion of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Lacrosse season, medals will be presented to the top four finishers on the leaderboard in addition to the Defensive Player of the Year and the Teammate of the Year. An All-Defensive Team will also be recognized as part of the closing ceremony.

ATHLETE COMPENSATION

Athletes are compensated in three ways during an Athletes Unlimited season, including base pay, win bonuses (quarter and game wins) and a leaderboard bonus. The leaderboard bonus also includes an additional donation equal to 100 percent of the athlete's win bonus to their selected cause partner.

MEDALS

The top four players on the final leaderboard in addition to the Defensive Player of the Year and the Teammate of the Year will receive a medal designed and fabricated for Athletes Unlimited by Lisa Issenberg, founder of Kiitellä, Inc. The front face of the medal represents the identity of Athletes Unlimited, while the back face of the medal leans into the specific sport, the year, location and words about Athletes Unlimited's vision, mission and values on and off the field - Excellence in Community and Leadership.

THE BOOK OF UNLIMITED

The Book of Unlimited was designed, handmade and bound for Athletes Unlimited. The book weighs nearly 25 pounds, measures approximately 12" by 18" and contains nearly 500 pages. The champion, along with all who competed, are inscribed into the book. In addition, The Book of Unlimited also contains a history of achievements in Athletes Unlimited, including stories, highlights and events.

The book is opened during the Opening Ceremony for each season and is closed after the champion is named and her name is inscribed into the book. The tradition began during Athletes Unlimited Softball's inaugural season in 2020.
