Attacker Charlotte North erupted for six points on five goals to lead Team Moreno past Team Read, 12-8, to open Week Two action of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season on Thursday evening. She now has 17 goals through the opening quartet of games to start the new campaign, which is the most in the leauge's four-year history. The University of North Carolina product also registered her 14th career two-point goal in the first quarter to set another AU Pro Lacrosse record as she pasted former player Nicole Levy for most two-point markers.

In addition, attacker Charlotte North's five goals in the 12-8 win for Team Moreno was her fifth career Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse game with five or more goals. The tally increased her league record and marked the 17th hat trick in her three years with AU Pro Lacrosse. #### **LUCKY NUMBER 13**

Goalkeeper and reigning two-time Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse champion Taylor Moreno made 10 saves in her team's 12-8 victory against Team Read on Thursday evening. With her play, she was awarded MVP 3 plaudits, which is her 13th career Game MVP honor. The total ranks her in a tie for fourth most postgame honors in AU Pro Lacrosse history and is the third goalkeeper to reach the top four spots on the ledger. The University of North Carolina standout has been a Game MVP in three of the four game days during the 2024 season.

# **AUSL TO DEBUT IN 2025**

- Athletes Unlimited announced the creation of the Athletes Unlimited Softball League (AUSL) in a press conference on June 4, 2024, in Oklahoma City.
- The traditional softball league will launch in 2025, complementing the existing AU Pro Softball Championship Season and creating a new opportunity for the world's best softball players.
- A minimum of four teams will compete during the inaugural season in 2025 with each squad playing a 30-game schedule. Each team will carry a 15-player roster.
- The AUSL will become a city-based league beginning in 2026, while the inaugural 2025 season will be a touring property.
- ESPN has signed on as a founding broadcast partner of the AUSL and will carry at least 18 games exclusively on its linear platforms (ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU) in 2025.

The single point extended her league record points streak to 43 consecutive games as she continues to register at least one point in every AU Pro Lacrosse game she has played in

#### 99 PROBLEMS BUT A GOAL AINT ONE

Attacker **Sam Apuzzo** was held off the goal scoring sheet in Thursday's game for just the third time in her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career. The Boston College standout leads the AU Pro Lacrosse goal scoring charts with 99 career goals and has registered a goal in 40 of her 43 contests in the league. The last time she was held without a goal was August 6, 2023 against Team Moreno and before that, Apuzzo notched at least one goal in every game leading back to a July 31, 2022 contest against Team Aresenault. Apuzzo looks to become the first player in league history to record 100 career goals

#### **HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO MYSELF**

Attacker **Sammy Jo Tracy** celebrated her birthday on July 25 and ended the day with Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action. Despite Team Read falling 12-8 to Team Moreno in the Week Two opener, Tracy registered a career-high and game-high nine draw controls with a goal, an assist and two ground balls. The nine draw controls bested her previous career high of three draws, which she accomplished three previous times in her AU Pro Lacrosse career. In addition, the game win was the 25th of her career, which ranks second most in league history.

#### KINNA GET AN AW YEAH?

Rookie midfielder **Megan Kinna** registered her first Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse two-point goal as Team Read faltered, 12-8, against Team Moreno in Thursday night's play. The league newcomer became the 31st player in the four-year history to net a two-point marker and ranks inside the top 10 in the 2024 season in points. Her seven goals on the season is tied for the seventh-highest in the new campaign. In addition, she finished with three goals to secure her second hat trick of the young season. She has two of the 16 hat tricks so far in 2024

#### **HOMETOWN HERO**

Rookie attacker **Isabella Peterson** has enjoyed a great start to her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career playing in her hometown as she finished with a hat trick in Team Read's 12-8 loss against Team Moreno on Thursday night. The Sparks, Maryland native sits in fifth on the league's stat chart with 11 points, which includes eight goals in four games. The James Madison graduate has had two games with three or more goals and is one of 29 players to register hat tricks in multiple games in AU Pro Lacrosse history.

#### **CONTROLLING THE NARRATIVE**

In Team Apuzzo's 10-6 win against Team McCool to close out day one of Week Two in the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season, Team Apuzzo dominated the draws with 16 wins out of 20 possible draw controls. The 16 draw controls matched a season-team high in the league, while the four draws for Team McCool was a season low. The Gold squad narrowly avoided matching an all-time low of three draw controls despite Team Apuzzo winning each of the first 13 draws in the contest.

#### IN-SCANE IN THE BRAIN

Rookie attacker **Izzy Scane** led Team Apuzzo with four goals in her squad's 10-6 win against Team McCool on Thursday night. The goal tally marked her second Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse game with at least four goals in just her fourth game of her professional career. The number marked the eighth four-goal performance in AU Pro Lacrosse in the 2024 season through the league's first eight total games.

#### **BE-LIVY IT**

Attacker **Livy Rosenzweig** grabbed eight draw controls in Team Moreno's 12-8 in against Team Read in the Week Two Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse opener on Thursday night. It was her fifth game with seven or more draw controls, which is tied for the most in league history. She joins 2021 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse champion Taylor Cummings as the only players to achieve the feat in at least five games.

- Rosenzweig also owns the league record with 13 draw controls in a single game.
- In addition, Rosenzeweig ranks ninth on the all-time draw control listing with 71 career draws despite playing in just 13 career contests.
  She is the only player in the top 10 on that ledger to appear in 13 games or fewer.
- No Rosenzeweig also leads the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse roster with 26 draw controls through the first eight games of the year.

#### **NALLS ON A CHALKBOARD**

Rookie defender Emily Nalls put forth a career effort in her team's 10-6 win against Team McCool on Thursday night's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action. The newcomer from the University of North Carolina picked up three ground balls to go with four draw controls and a caused turnover as she earned her first career Game MVP honor with an MVP 1 accommendation to open Week Two. The defender utilized the performance to acquire a career-high 196 leaderboard points and move up three spots in the standings to fifth entering Saturday's games.

#### **FINDING OTHER WAYS**

Despite not scoring a goal and being held to just one point, attacker **Sam Apuzzo** still managed to register 193 leaderboard points in her squad's 10-6 win against Team McCool on Thursday night. The Boston College standout grabbed nine draw controls, which tied her career high, and surpassed the 100 draw control mark for her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career. She is just the second player to reach the 100-draw control milestone and also registered her 21st game with 150 or more leaderboard points. Apuzzo is the only player in the league's four-year history to achieve 150 or more points in 20 games or more.

#### **SENDING GOOD GRACE-S**

Midfielder **Grace Griffin** stepped up for her team on Thursday evening's 10-6 win against Team McCool to close out the fourth game day of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season. The Maryland native and former Terrapin standout finished the night with two goals and an assist to go along with a caused turnover and a ground ball. Griffin registered her fourth-career multi-goal game and garnered 145 leaderboard points to vault 12 places into 17th on the overall leaderboard, which is the highest spot she's seen this season. The midfielder finished the first game day of the 2024 campaign in 51st place.

### **CHASING 100**

Defender **Caroline Wakefield** is still chasing the 100-ground ball milestone after scooping up a pair of loose balls on Thursday night. The University of North Carolina product remains the all-time leader in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history and is looking to become the first player in league history to reach 100 ground balls. # IN CASE WE GO TO OVERTIME ...

- There have been six overtime games in the three-year history of Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse ... In addition, there have been two games that required a shootout.
- Attacker Sam Apuzzo holds a 2-0 record in overtime contests ... Her squad defeated Team Moreno in the first-ever shootout by an 11-10 count on July 30, 2022, before edging Team Bosco, 7-6, on August 5, 2023.
- If a game requires overtime, players do not accumulate any individual stat points ... Only game win points and any quarter win points that rolled over from the end of regulation are awarded.
- Overtime in AU Pro Lacrosse consists of a three-minute "sudden victory" period ... If the score remains tied following the extra period, the game moves into a shootout to determine the winner.
- The shootout will consist of three rounds with a player attempting to score from outside the eight-meter key ... If the score is tied after the third round, teams will continue playing one round at a time until there is a winner.

#### HAVING A BALL

Rookie defender **Meghan Ball** secured a career-best three caused turnovers in Team McCool's 10-6 loss to Team Apuzzo on Thursday night's Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse action. The Maryland Terrapin also picked up a ground ball and stands with six caused turnovers and eight GBs through her first four professional games of her career.

#### SHUT THE DORNEY

Second-year midfielder Hannah Dorney scooped up a career-high four ground balls in Thursday's loss against Team Apuzzo. The four ground balls were her first of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season and bested her previous career high mark of three GBs that she recorded on July 27, 2023 against Team Colson in last season's competition. Dorney also has two goals on the season, including a two-point strike, to stand with three points going into Saturday's games.

#### **PURPLE PEOPLE EATERS**

Through the first eight games of competition in the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season, the teams sporting Purple have moved to a league best 3-1 record. Defender Abby Bosco touted a 2-1 record as a captain in Week One before attacker Sam Apuzzo guided her team to a win to kick off Week Two. Meanwhile, Gold teams stand at 2-2, while the Orange and Blue squads hold a 2-2 mark entering Saturday.

#### I'M COMING FOR THAT NUMBER ONE SPOT

Attacker Sam **Apuzzo** finished the fourth game day of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season atop the leaderboard with 587 points. She is the fourth player to take top billing in the standings through the four game days after rookie attacker **Maggi Hall** was leading the charge after the opening day of play, goalkeeper and reigning two-time AU Pro Lacrosse champion **Taylor Moreno** led after the second game day and midfielder **Marie McCool** topped the charts following day three to earn her first time as a captain in charge of the Gold shirts.

#### THE KENNEDY CENTER

Midfielder **Ally Kennedy** jumped into the top four on the Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse standings after a 168 leaderboard point performance on Thursday. Kennedy was able to help guide Team Moreno to a victory afer scoring a pair of goals with an assist to go with two ground balls and a pair of caused turnovers. The Stony Brook product moves back into the top four with 516 total leaderboard points and moves her season total to eight points on six goals and a pair of assists.

#### **VETERAN CAPTAINS**

Tonight features the fourth match up between teams captained by goalkeeper **Britt Read** and attacker **Sam Apuzzo** in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history. The duo faced off as captains for the first time on July 23, 2022 with Team Apuzzo coming out on top, 12-5, before Team Read earned a 14-8 victory against Apuzzo's squad on July 22, 2023. The rubber match between the two took place on July 27, 2023 with Team Apuzzo earning a close 8-7 victory.

#### **MAKING MOVES**

Two players matched the biggest moves on the Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse leaderboard following Thursday night's contests. Midfielder **Lindsey McKone** and attacker **Livy Rosenzweig** each vaulted 17 places up the standings moving into game day five of the 2024 AU Pro Lacrosse season.

#### **STATS MATTER**

With her nine saves against Team Moreno on Thursday night, goalkeeper **Britt Read** continued to lead Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse's all-time stat point ledger. The Oregon netminder has collected 1,678 stat points and stands as the all-time leader in goalkeeper saves with 342. It marked the 16th time she has made nine or more saves in an AU Pro Lacrosse game.

# **CEASE AND ASSIST**

#### **4K GOLD**

Goalkeeper **Taylor Moreno** became the seventh player in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history to record at least 4,000 career leaderboard points as she finished Thursday night with 4,003 points towards the standings in her three seasons. Attacker Sam Apuzzo is the only player to reach 5,000 points with a total of 5,721, while goalkeeper Britt Read and Kady Glynn round out the top three players in the ledger with 4,698 points and 4,680 points, respectively.

#### PROFESSIONAL LEAGUES FOR THE WORLD'S BEST ATHLETES

The 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse season is not the only AU league competing this weekend. The Athletes Unlimited Pro Softball Championship series began on Friday evening for its fifth season of competition. Contests will be played over the next five weekends for one athlete to claim the fifth AU Pro Softball Championship season title. Softball was Athletes Unlimited's first professional league and features 60 of the world's greatest players. The season is hosted at the Parkway Bank Sports Complex in Rosemont, Illinois.

#### **DRAFT DOTS: WEEK TWO**

- Goalkeeper Taylor Moreno enters her ninth consecutive week as a team captain, but will be wearing a color other than Gold for the first time as a team leader when she dons the Blue jersey ... It is the first time Moreno has worn a jersey other than Gold or Orange in her career.
- Attacker Sam Apuzzo will be wearing the Purple jersey for just the third time in her four-year Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career ... Week Two will mark the first time she has donned the Purple top since Week Three of the inaugural 2021 campaign.
- Apuzzo also embarks on her 10th consecutive stint as a team captain, carrying a 20-7 all-time mark as a team captain into Week Two ... She is also the league's all-time leader with 26 overall victories.
- Apuzzo's 10 career weeks as a captain are tied for second among all Athletes Unlimited athletes in any sport ... Guard Odyssey Sims (basketball) holds the all-time mark with 11 weeks as a team captain, while outside hitter Bethania De La Cruz (volleyball) follows in second place with 10 weeks as a captain.
- Goalkeeper Britt Read, who is making her fifth career weekly appearance as a captain, joins fellow netminder Kady Glynn as the only players in league history to serve as a team captain in every
- Read will be wearing the Orange iersey for the sixth time in her AU Pro Lacrosse career, including two of the last three weeks.
- Midfielder Marie McCool becomes the 19th player in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history to serve as a team captain after finishing the opening week with a league-high 443 leaderboard points McCool will also be wearing the Gold jersey for the seventh time in her AU Pro Lacrosse career, the most of any jersey color.
- Rookie attacker Izzy Scane was the first overall selection for a second consecutive week and will also wear Purple for the second week in a row ... The NCAA's all-time goal scoring leader is just the second player to be selected first overall in back-to-back weeks ... Attacker Sam Apuzzo was the top pick in Week Two and Week Three during the inaugural 2021 campaign.
- Defender Caroline Wakefield sports the Gold jersey for the sixth consecutive week and wears the color for the ninth time in her career ... She has worn Gold more than any other player in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse history, surpassing Taylor Moreno's eight instances ... Catcher Dejah Mulipola is the only player to wear the Gold jersey more than Wakefield, doing so 10 times during her AU Pro Softball Championship Season career.
- Defender Meg Douty will wear the Purple jersey for the eighth time in her 15 weeks in the league, which is the most in AU Pro Lacrosse history ... She has been selected to the Purple squad in four of the last six weeks dating back to last season.
- For just the second time in her Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career, defender Kristen Carr will don the Orange jersey ... The North Carolina product, who is a member of the Orange squad for the first time since Week Three last season, wore Purple in each of the previous three weeks.
- Midfielder Lindsey McKone was selected to Team Apuzzo and will put on the Purple iersey for the fifth time in the last six weeks ... She has worn the Purple top seven times in her 15 career weekly seaments.
- Attacker Andie Aldave was selected 20th in the draft for a second straight week and will wear the Gold jersey for the fourth straight week ... Representing North Carolina and Notre Dame, Aldave has worn Gold more than any other color in her AU Pro Lacrosse career
- This is the second straight week that only goalkeepers were selected in the 12th round.
- For the fourth time in her six-week Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse career, midfielder Hannah Dorney will wear the Gold jersey ... The former Notre Dame standout wore Purple in Week One and opened her career by wearing Orange in Week One last season.
- The biggest mover on the draft board was attacker Sam Geiersbach, who jumped 24 spots on the draft board ... She was selected 40th in Week One before moving inside the top 20 at No. 16 on Monday night.
- Seven of the top 15 picks were Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse newcomers, including five of the top 10 choices ... Attacker Sydni Black rose 16 places from Week One to Week Two as she was the first pick of the second round by Team McCool.
- All three Stony Brook products will play for Team Moreno in Week Two ... Midfielder Ally Kennedy was the squad's first round selection before rookie midfielder Ellie Masera followed in the third round ... Attacker Kailyn Hart went to Team Moreno in the 11th round.
- This is the first time in five weeks that Apuzzo and midfielder Dempsey Arsenault will be on opposing teams after Arsenault was taken by Team McCool to close the first round.
- Attacker Livy Rosenzweig joins Team Blue for the fourth time in her six weeks in Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse ... The Lovola Maryland product dropped a league-high 27 spots on the draft board to No. 34 overall ... She leads the league with 18 draw controls and registered one goal and one assist.
- Rookie midfielder Sierra Cockerille moved up 16 places on the draft order with the 36th overall pick of the Week Two draft ... The lone Syracuse product on the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse roster is in Gold for the second straight week.

# **ATHLETES UNLIMITED PRO LACROSSE 101**

#### **WHO WE ARE**

Athletes Unlimited is a new model of professional sports where athletes are decision makers and individual players are champions of team sports. We literally change the game with faster play and fluid teams, delivering next-level competition and engagement in which every moment counts. Starting in 2020 with Women's Softball and following with Women's Volleyball (2021), Women's Lacrosse (2021), Women's Basketball (2022) and AUX Softball (2022), Athletes Unlimited will build the next generation of both athletes and fans.

Our athletes are in charge of their team and league decisions, and of their individual success. We reboot timetables, rosters, and gameplay to create fast and exciting competition that speaks to contemporary sports fans, bringing them close to the action and the athletes in games where every moment counts. We incorporate the player-centric model that fans love about fantasy sports. We use digital media platforms and cutting-edge technology to connect fans deeply to athletes at the top of their game on and off the field, and to the game itself.

# **HOW THE TEAMS ARE SELECTED**

A draft will be held prior to each week's games with the top four players in the individual leaderboard serving as the team captains. The captains will then fill their rosters by selecting 13 other players. Each week's draft will be held on the Monday before the respective week's games.

Uniform colors will be assigned based on the team captain's rank on the leaderboard. The top-scoring captain's team will wear gold, while the second-highest point scorer's team dons orange jerseys. The third-place team will wear blue jerseys and the fourth-place team will wear purple jerseys.

All teams will consist of 14 players, including four attackers, four midfielders, four defenders and two goalkeepers.

#### **RULES OF INTEREST**

Athletes Unlimited Pro Lacrosse playing rules are based on the NCAA rule book with several exceptions, including:

**Fleld Size:** The field is 100 yards long by 60 yards wide with 80 yards between the goals. In addition, the restraining line is the center line, but restraining lines will be in use for the draw. Instead of an eight-meter fan, Athletes Unlimited Lacrosse will use an eight-meter "key."

**Timing:** Four 10-minute (10:00) stopped time quarters will be played during a regulation game with a 60-second shot clock in play. There will be a three-minute (3:00) break between the first and second quarters and third and fourth quarters. Halftime will be 15 minutes in length.

**Shot Clock Reset:** The 60-second shot clock will reset if a shot attempt is a goal, saved by the goalkeeper or hits the crossbar or goal post.

**Timeouts:** Each team is permitted to take one timeout per quarter, but timeouts do not carry over if unused. If a team does not take a timeout before the five-minute mark of the quarter, a media timeout will be called at the next dead ball situation. The first timeout of any quarter (media or team-called) will be three minutes (3:00) in length and any subsequent timeouts in the period will be one minute (1:00) in length.

**Overtime and Shootouts:** In the event a game is tied at the end of regulation, a three-minute overtime period will be played following a one-minute break. If the game is still tied following overtime, a shootout will take place to determine the winner following a one-minute break. Three shooters from each team will alternate taking attempts from outside the eight-meter key with the team scoring more goals winning the shootout. If the shootout remains tied after three rounds, the shootout will move into a sudden-victory format where any player on the roster may take an attempt, including those who have previously participated in the shootout.

**Foul Changes:** Shooting space fouls are not called in Athletes Unlimited; however, walling will be enforced. Defenders cannot intentionally enter the shooting lane of an attacking player with the intent of blocking a shot. In addition, teams cannot intentionally position any number of defenders in front of the goal. Defenders are prohibited from entering the restricted area directly in front of the goal unless they maintain a one-stick length from the attacking player (Walling can still be called on a defender outside of the restricted area if they attempt to impede the attacking player's shot). No three-second defensive calls will be made and no touch fouls will be called, but players cannot be significantly displaced.

**Dangerous Shots:** Dangerous shot fouls can be called by the game officials. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team on or above the knee, a red card will be administered to the offending player. If a shot attempt hits a player on either team below the knee, a yellow card will be administered to the offending player.

**Over and Back:** Teams may not go back into the defensive half of the field once they establish possession in the offensive half. If a team violates this rule, possession is turned over to the defensive team.

**Challenges:** Teams will be permitted two (2) challenges per game, which are communicated to the officials via the captain or facilitator. The following situations may be challenged:

- Goals
- · 2-Point Goals
- · Whether the ball was out of the crosse when time expires in a period
- Dangerous Shots
- · False Starts

Teams DO NOT retain their challenges if they are successful. The Challenge Official will make the final decision on all challenges.

**Scoring:** Teams may score a two-point goal if the shot is released outside the eight-meter key. In addition, goalkeepers can score with a goalkeeper crosse during game play (regulation and overtime).

#### **INDIVIDUAL LEADERBOARD**

While traditional lacrosse statistics are kept during each game, players earn individual points by accumulating those statistics. Those points are used to create an individual leaderboard, which determines each week's captains and the individual champion at the end of the season.

Points are awarded at the following increments during the game:

If a game requires overtime and/or a shootout, the stats accumulated during the extra period or shootout do not earn any individual points for the athletes on the leaderboard.

In addition, athletes will be awarded 20 individual points if their team wins a single quarter. If the teams score the same number of points (goals + two-point goals) in a quarter, the points carry over to the next quarter.

Athletes on the winning team in each game will be awarded 45 individual points toward the leaderboard.

Three MVPs will be selected following each game by the athletes with the top player earning 45 points. The second MVP will receive 30 points, while the third MVP claims 15 points.

#### **POSTSEASON AWARDS**

At the conclusion of the 2024 Athletes Unlimited Lacrosse season, medals will be presented to the top four finishers on the leaderboard in addition to the Defensive Player of the Year and the Teammate of the Year. An All-Defensive Team will also be recognized as part of the closing ceremony.

# **ATHLETE COMPENSATION**

Athletes are compensated in three ways during an Athletes Unlimited season, including base pay, win bonuses (quarter and game wins) and a leaderboard bonus. The leaderboard bonus also includes an additional donation equal to 100 percent of the athlete's win bonus to their selected cause partner.

### **MEDALS**

The top four players on the final leaderboard in addition to the Defensive Player of the Year and the Teammate of the Year will receive a medal designed and fabricated for Athletes Unlimited by Lisa Issenberg, founder of Kiitellä, Inc. The front face of the media represents the identity of Athletes Unlimited, while the back face of the medal leans into the specific sport, the year, location and words about Athletes Unlimited's vision, mission and values on and off the field - Excellence in Community and Leadership.

# THE BOOK OF UNLIMITED

The Book of Unlimited was designed, handmade and bound for Athletes Unlimited. The book weighs nearly 25 pounds, measures approximately 12" by 18" and contains nearly 500 pages. The champion, along with all who competed, are inscribed into the book. In addition, The Book of Unlimited also contains a history of achievements in Athletes Unlimited, including stories, highlights and events.

The book is opened during the Opening Ceremony for each season and is closed after the champion is named and her name is inscribed into the book. The tradition began during Athletes Unlimited Softball's inaugural season in 2020.
